- 1 Le Dolci Colline Prosecco Spumante NV** **24.00**  
Adria Vini, Venezie, Italy  
Fresh and gently fruity with citrus and green apple aromas. Delicate and lively on the palate with ripe, lightly grapey fruit, zesty acidity and a clean, refreshing finish.
- 2 Crémant de Limoux Brut NV** **34.00**  
Domaine Philippe Collin, Limoux, Languedoc, France  
With a light, frothy mousse, attractive biscuity nose and crisp, dry, spankingly-clean palate, this Crémant de Limoux Brut is a terrific choice.

## - CHAMPAGNE -

- 10 Gremillet Sélection Brut NV** **45.00**  
Aube Valley, France  
Fresh floral aromas balanced with rich fruit characters and classic crisp citrus finish. ideal as an aperitif.
- 11 Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial NV** **55.00**  
Epernay, France  
Aromas of apple, pear, white peach, lemon and elegant notes of brioche and fresh nuts. The palate is seductive, richly flavourful and smooth followed by a delicately fresh crispness.
- SP Laurent-Perrier Brut NV** **55.00**  
Tours Sur Marne, France  
With a high percentage of Chardonnay this Champagne is pale gold in colour with aromas that are delicate yet complex, fresh and balanced with hints of citrus and white fruits. The palate is well defined, subtly rounded with expressive flavours.
- 12 Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Yellow Label Brut NV** **65.00**  
Reims, France  
The predominance of Pinot Noir provides the structure, while a touch of Pinot Meunier rounds out the blend. Chardonnay adds the elegance and finesse essential in a perfectly balanced wine.
- 13 Bollinger Special Cuvee NV** **70.00**  
Ay, France  
Aromas of roast apples, apple compote and peaches with a palate of pear, brioche and notes of fresh walnut.
- 14 Moët & Chandon Rosé Impérial NV** **75.00**  
Epernay, France  
Pink with amber highlights, it has an intense bouquet of summer fruits with a slight hint of pepper - perfect with puddings as well as an aperitif.
- 15 Moët & Chandon Grand Vintage 2006** **95.00**  
Epernay, France  
Deeply structured this vintage is fleshy ample and smooth. The first notes of vanilla almond and hazelnuts are followed by sun-soaked summer fruits giving way to a soft spiciness. This is a profound champagne.
- 16 Perrier Jouet Belle Epoque Vintage 2007** **140.00**  
Epernay, France  
Aromas of white fruits - lemon, white peach, pear and grapefruit give away to hints of pineapple and fresh spring flowers.

Epernay, France  
Exhibiting aromas and flavors of lemon oil, orange rind, and brioche in a medium-bodied, zesty, rich, intense style.

### Loire

- 20 Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie 2015** **24.00**  
Domaine de la Batardiere, Loire Valley, France  
Ageing on the lees gives this wine added depth and complexity. Fresh and hard to resist.
- 21 Menetou-Salon Eric Louis 2012** **34.00**  
Domaine Eric Louis, Thauvenay, France  
Menetou Salon Whites are made with Sauvignon Blanc grapes grown on mineral-rich soils just to the Southwest of Sancerre. This excellent example is fresh and fruity with notes of citrus and white flowers and a long mineral finish.
- 22 Pouilly Fumé 2015** **38.00**  
Cédric Bardin, Pouilly-sur-Loire, France  
Intense nose of citrus fruits and nettle with herbaceous notes, great concentration on the palate with well balanced acidity and refreshing minerality.
- 23 Sancerre Blanc 2015** **40.00**  
Domaine Sautereau, Crèzancy, France  
Vibrant aromas of nettle, grapefruit and passionfruit. The palate is elegant in texture, with refreshing acidity and medium body.

### Burgundy

- 30 Bourgogne Aligoté 'Closierie des Alisiers' 2015** **34.00**  
Domaine Stéphane Brocard, Burgundy, France  
Young and fruity, this wine shows the natural crispness of the Aligoté. It has minerality, acidity and layers of fruitiness - it makes a great sharpener!
- 31 Chablis 2015** **37.00**  
Dauvissat, Chablis, France  
Intensely fresh and mineral, packed with fragrant fruits and flowers. The finish is long and precise. Elegant and delightful.
- 32 Macon-Igé 'Château London' 2014** **40.00**  
Jean-Claude Boisset, Nuits-St-Georges, Burgundy, France  
Bright, with an attractive nose of white flowers, citrus and peach. The palate is lively with long, zesty acidity on the finish.
- 33 Chablis 1er Cru 'Les Vaudevey' 2014** **45.00**  
Domaine Laroche, Chablis, Burgundy, France  
One of the finest 1ier crus in Chablis, bright pale gold with aromas of ripe apples, citrus, hay and a touch of honey. This is a textured and complex wine with lovely minerality and flavours that linger on a long finish.
- 34 St Aubin 1er Cru 'La Chataniere' 2013** **55.00**  
Domaine Roux, Burgundy, France  
The colour of sunshine. Aromas of white flowers, flint, green almond, and orange-flower. Rich and firm, just delicious.
- 35 Chassagne-Montrachet 'Les Chaumes' 2012** **60.00**  
Domaine Roux, Burgundy, France  
A mature, complex and sophisticated wine with depth and character - ripe yellow and green fruits, good spice and a touch of blossom.
- 36 Meursault 'Sous La Velle' 2013** **65.00**  
Moret-Nominé, Beaune, Burgundy, France  
A fragrant, ripe, full fruited bouquet which continues onto the palate and persists into a finish of great finesse.

## Alsace

- 40 Pinot Blanc 'Klevner' Réserve 2014** **30.00**  
Cave de Hunawihr, Alsace, France  
Pale straw yellow in colour, the nose is full of youth and freshness, typical of this vintage. It opens with fine hints of apricot and yellow plum. The mouth is full and very fresh.
- 41 Gewürztraminer Réserve 2014** **32.00**  
Cave de Turckheim, Alsace, France  
Pale golden colour with perfumed aromatics of lychees, rose petals and spice. A fantastic wine with great complexity, full bodied with spice and intense fruit on the finish.

## Regional France

- 60 Picpoul de Pinet 2015** **25.00**  
Baron de Badassière, Languedoc, France  
Bright yellow in colour with vibrant citrus, pear and spice notes on the nose. The palate is full but extremely well-balanced, with fresh Picpoul acidity and pure fruit flavours.
- 61 Chardonnay de La Chevalière 2015** **28.00**  
Mas La Chevaliere, Languedoc, France  
Gold in colour, this wine is lovely and expressive, rich and full of peach and apricot aromas with tropical notes.
- 62 Costières de Nîmes 2015** **32.00**  
Château Roubaud, Languedoc, France  
Made from 60% Roussanne and 40% Grenache Blanc, it makes an ideal aperitif and stands up well to food too.

## Italy

- 71 Pinot Grigio Principato 2015** **22.00**  
Principato, IGT Pavia, Italy  
Appealing fruit aromas mingle with delicate floral notes. Crisp, light and elegant.
- 72 Gavi di Gavi 2014** **27.00**  
Comune di Gavi Patrizi, Piemonte, Italy  
Delicate with intense fruity & lemony notes. Clean and fresh with a long lingering citrusy finish.
- 73 Pieropan Soave 2015** **30.00**  
Leonildo Pieropan, Soave, Veneto, Italy  
Fresh and expressive, with a character of white flowers, almond blossom and a touch of citrus. It has great balance between rounded, ripe fruit and a fresh, clean acidity. Long and fragrant.
- 74 Pinot Grigio Dolomiti 2014** **32.00**  
Alois Lageder, Alto Adige, Italy  
Brilliant straw yellow with a green shimmer, an expressive aroma with flowery and somewhat spicy notes. Rich flavoured in the mouth, with a slight smokiness leading to a good, fresh finish.
- 75 Roero Arneis San Michele 2014** **32.00**  
Deltetto Azienda Agricola Canale, Piemonte, Italy  
Soft and well-balanced, an attractive and aromatic nose with vanilla, apple and exotic fruit notes. Fresh, clean and elegant on the palate with good length and a crisp, floral finish.
- 76 Franz Haas "Manna" 2013** **46.00**  
Trentino, Alto Adige, Italy  
Franz produces wines that show a rare purity and balance and light gold in colour, Manna Cru is a perfectly balanced blend combining depth and texture, perfume and body to produce a crisp, lively wine with tremendous length and character.

## Spain

- 80 Macabeo 2015** **20.00**  
Bodegas Borsao, Campo de Borja, Spain  
On the nose, citrus and tropical fruit aromas. In the mouth it's creamy and fresh, in perfect harmony with the acidity.
- 81 K-Naia 2015** **26.00**  
Bodegas Naia, La Seca, Rueda, Spain  
Made with 85% Verdejo and 15% Sauvignon Blanc grapes, this wine delivers intense sensations of refreshing white fruit and crisp minerality. It is very approachable and goes with food or as an aperitif.
- 82 Vetus 'Flor de Vetus' rueda Verdejo 2014** **28.00**  
Toro, Castilla y Leon, Spain  
A crisp, fresh style of Verdejo from Rueda DO where the Izadi family also own vineyards. On the nose it is intense and harmonious with a rich citrus and peach fruit character. On the palate tropical notes with ripe lemon touches lead onto a long, lively and refreshing finish.
- 83 Albariño 'A2O' 2014** **30.00**  
Castro Martin, Rías Baixas, Spain  
Fresh and zesty with aromatic peach, apricot and lime zest on the nose. The palate is sleek and racy with juicy green apple, a hint of honey, crisp lemon and lime acidity.

## Austria

- 90 Grüner Veltliner 'Lois' 2014** **32.00**  
Loimer, Kamptal, Austria  
Youthful lemon in colour with lively, crisp nose with perfumes of fresh green apples and a touch of blackcurrant on the nose. It has a characteristic spicy quality to the palate, with a perfect balance between zesty acidity and ripe fruit.

## Germany

- 95 Reisling Pfalz Wolf 2015** **27.00**  
Dr Loosen, Pfalz, Germany  
An off-dry Riesling with honeyed, peachy, green apple fruit on both the nose and palate. Juicy and forward on the palate, it has a beautiful streak of fresh acidity to cut the sweetness and leave everything perky and fresh on the finish.
- 96 Dreissigacker Estate Reisling 2015** **34.00**  
Dreissigacker, Rheinhessen, Germany  
Jochen Dreissigacker has caused a considerable stir both in his native Germany and abroad, winning high praise and points wherever his wines are sold. Light in colour with green reflexes. The fruity, elegant nose is rich and medium-bodied, with aromas of ripe fruits. The palate is elegant, very well-balanced, and full of yellow fruit character before a long finish.

## New Zealand

- 110 The Cloud Factory Sauvignon Blanc 2016** **26.00**  
Cloud Factory, Marlborough, New Zealand  
Perfumed with ripe tropical fruits which are also evident on the palate along with limey flavours and a rich minerality - classic Marlborough Sauvignon. The wine fresh, clean and delicious.
- 111 Greywacke Sauvignon Blanc 2014** **36.00**  
Greywacke, Marlborough, New Zealand  
Greywacke was created in 2009 by Kevin Judd, chief winemaker at Cloudy Bay from its inception for 25 years and instrumental in the international recognition which Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc enjoys now. Deliciously aromatic, exuding enticing fruit fragrance.
- 112 Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2015** **46.00**  
Cloudy Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand  
Iconic Sauvignon Blanc from one of the leading producers of it in the world.

## Australia

- 121 Dandelion Reisling 'Enchanted Garden of the Eden Valley' 2015** **30.00**  
Dandelion Vineyards, Eden Valley, South Australia  
Classic aromatics of citrus zest and a clear steely minerality, bone dry underpinned by structure and nice acidity.
- 122 Hollick 'Bond Road' Reserve Chardonnay 2011** **38.00**  
Hollick Wines, Coonawarra, South Australia  
Aromas of nectarine, grapefruit, melon and citrus, powerful with pronounced flavours of pear, fig and apple. A complex wine with good balance and persistence.

## South Africa

- 130 Darling Chenin Blanc 2016** **27.00**  
Fairview, Paarl, South Africa  
A fresh, lively perfume of ripe pears and honeysuckle, rich and rounded, with a crisp finish.
- 131 Glen Carlou Chardonnay 2014** **30.00**  
Hess Family Estates, Paarl, South Africa  
Glen Carlou is a member of the biodiversity and wine initiative and this Chardonnay has been aged in French barrels, giving a ripe full body, that maintains its elegance on the palate.

## South America

- 140 Vetas Blancas Reserva Chardonnay 2015** **30.00**  
Viña Tabalí, Valle del Limarí, Chile  
Fresh and intense with nice mineral and citrus aromas. Nice acidity and freshness on the palate with a very long and pleasant finish.

## USA

- 150 Cline North Coast Viognier 2014** **30.00**  
Cline Cellars, Sonoma, California, USA  
Fermented in steel and kept well away from oak barrels this Viognier shows big peach and apricot flavours mixed with citrus and floral notes. Full-bodied and a powerhouse of flavour.
- 151 Rochioli "Estate" Chardonnay 2013** **75.00**  
Russian River Valley, Sonoma, USA  
Awarded 95 points by Robert Parker. This iconic winery has produced a wine that has a chablis like minerality and crispness. Displaying notes of citrus and subdued oak on the palate.

- 200 Saint Nicolas de Bourgueil "L'Expression" 2015** **32.00**  
Talauu and Foltzenlogel, Saint Nicolas de Bourgueil, Loire Valley, France  
An easy-drinking and expressive capsicum-scented Cabernet Franc. This has a lovely concentration of fruit and a really persistent finish.

### Beaujolais

- 210 Beaujolais-Villages 2015** **29.00**  
Dominique Morel, Domaine de Gry-Sablon, Beaujolais, France  
Clear ruby with delicate cherry perfumes. The rounded palate is full of fresh red berry fruit. Elegant, well balanced with good acidity, a great example of Beaujolais-Villages.
- 211 Fleurie 2013** **34.00**  
Cave de Fleurie, Beaujolais, France  
Striking and vivid red in colour, with several punnets worth of red berry fruit on the nose and palate. Soft and fresh with light, ripe tannins and crisp acidity.
- 212 Brouilly 2013** **36.00**  
Chateau de Pierreux, Beaujolais, France  
Brilliant colour with deep purple nuances. Fine, elegant nose with floral notes of iris, violet and peony. Soft and round on the palate with lovely length revealing floral and dark berry flavours of blueberry and blackcurrant.

### Burgundy

- 220 Bourgogne Pinot Noir 'Les Ursulines' 2014** **40.00**  
Jean-Claude Boisset, Nuits-St-Georges, Burgundy, France  
Firmness, attractive cherry perfume and scented length expected of far greater wines. Excellent value.
- 221 Givry Vieilles Vignes 2014** **44.00**  
Domaine Ragot, Givry, Burgundy, France  
A nose of blackcurrant and blackberry, well structured and balanced on the palate. Long, lingering Pinot flavours supported by fine tannins.
- 222 Gevrey-Chambertin 2012** **56.00**  
Domaine Dominique Gallois, Burgundy, France  
The wine has great richness and intensity, with the concentration derived from the careful management of old vines. On the nose it shows aromas of ripe, dark berry fruit with an intensely earthy character. On the palate it is fresh and vibrant.

## Bordeaux

- 230 Château Rousseau de Sipian 2011** **34.00**  
Médoc, Bordeaux, France  
Now starting to show some lovely bottle age, blackcurrant and blackberry on the nose, the delicious maturity shows on the palate, then ends with a long mellow finish.
- 231 Château D'Abzac 2013** **36.00**  
Bordeaux Supérieur, Bordeaux, France  
Château d'Abzac is located 6km north west of Pomerol where this wine is made from mainly merlot grapes. Its alluring red berry aromas precede a palate that has a wealth of cassis flavours, great concentration and fine balance. It really is very nice.
- 232 Château La Lagune 'Mademoiselle L' 2013** **44.00**  
Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, France  
With inviting perfumes of cassis and light vanilla, this is a well-structured wine that is full of red fruit flavours, which intermingle with notes of blackcurrant and plum. The gentle oak supports the supple tannins on the long finish of red and black berries.
- 233 Château Tour de Capet 2012** **49.00**  
Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux, France  
Made mainly from Merlot, giving juicy cassis and plum fruit flavours and an appealing round finish. A small proportion of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc give a lifted perfume and cedar flavour to the palate.
- 234 Château Durfort-Vivens "Vivens" 2010** **55.00**  
Margaux, Bordeaux, France  
The nose has intense aromas of cassis and blackberries. Ample and round with soft tannins and spicy notes. A very stylish and balanced wine.
- 235 Château Petit Village 'Le jardin de Petit Village' 2012** **68.00**  
Pomerol, Bordeaux, France  
The nose is concentrated with floral notes, red and black fruit as well as exotic woods and leather. On the palate there are fine tannins and very pleasant fruity flavours with well integrated oak, finishing with great length.
- 236 Chateau Batailley, Pauillac 2007** **75.00**  
Chateau Batailley, Pauillac, Beaujolais, France  
One of the oldest Chateau's in Pauillac. The 2007 vintage has an attractive expressive cabernet nose with notes of cassis on the palate. A very classic left bank claret with a touch of dry tannin on the finish.



## Rhone

- 240 Côtes du Rhône 2014** **24.00**  
Domaine de la Griveliere, Saint Géniès de Comolas, Rhône, France  
Powerful and concentrated with ripe blackberry, raspberry and spicy notes. Full-bodied on the palate with soft tannins balanced by the right acidity.
- 241 Lirac 2012** **30.00**  
Moulin des Chênes, Lirac, Rhône, France  
Full and soft, made mainly from Syrah, Grenache and Mourvèdre. It is generous in body with supple tannins and primary fruit. Fresh, with a long, mellow finish.
- 242 Crozes Hermitage 'La Rollande' 2014** **34.00**  
Maison Brotte, Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Rhône, France  
A nose of intense blackcurrant with spicy notes. Harmonious on the palate with a long and flavourful finish.
- 243 Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2012** **48.00**  
Domaine Chante Cigale, Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Rhône, France  
Deep purple with violet hues. A rich deep nose of red and black fruits and spices. Soft and round in the mouth with a harmonious and persistent finish.
- 244 Gigondas 'Domaine des Bosquets' 2011** **49.00**  
Château de Vaudieu, Gigondas, Rhône, France  
Purple, inky colour. A complex nose of black and red berries, liquorice and violets. Generous, ripe fruit with huge depth and fresh lingering finish.

## Regional France

- 248 Pinot Noir Reserve 2014** **25.00**  
St. Martin, Pays D'Oc France  
Aromas of cherries and plums with a hint of redcurrant . Attractive floral notes also shine through.
- 249 Saint-Chinian "Cuveé Magali" 2012** **30.00**  
Jean Lacugue, Ch. Milhau-Lacugue, Puisseguier, Languedoc, France  
Made from roughly equal volumes of Syrah, Grenache Noir and Carignan, it is a juicy, readily accessible wine packed with ripe plum and berry flavours over a framework of supple tannins.

## Italy

- 250 Chianti 'Da Vinci' 2014** **27.00**  
Cantine Leonardo, Tuscany, Italy  
Good depth of ruby colour and a lovely, forward fragrance of fresh plums and warm, spicy blackberries. Full-bodied with soft supple tannins.
- 251 Valpolicella Ripasso 'Corte Giara' 2014** **34.00**  
Agricola Allegrini, Fumane, Verona, Italy  
Characteristic perfumes of dark cherries with a hint of the richness and slightly raisined notes reminiscent of Amarone, giving way to a rich, ripe fruity palate with just enough tannins to support the fruit on the finish.
- 252 Cesconi 'Moratel' 2012** **36.00**  
Trentino, Alto Adige, Italy  
Made with 40% Lagrein, 40% Merlot, 10% Teroldego and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. The nose is aromatic and complex, full of cherry, raspberry and blackcurrant. On the palate it is nicely balanced with a long lingering finish. A really nice choice.
- 253 Barolo Patrizi 2012** **46.00**  
Cantine Manfredi, Piemonte, Italy  
Open and spicy nose with notes of berry fruits, plum, wood smoke and leather. Rich red berry fruit on the palate with good concentration, hints of spicy tar, liquorice and meaty notes. A warm mid-palate leading to the characteristic firm, structured finish.
- 254 Brunello di Montalcino 'Palazzo Comunale' 2008** **62.00**  
Cantina di Montalcino, Tuscany, Italy  
Good depth of purple colour, with perfumes of prunes and blackberries on the nose. On the palate it is full-bodied, with a solid structure, attractive autumnal soft fruit characters and smoky, woodland note on the finish.

## Spain

- 260 Garnacha Tinto 2015** **20.00**  
Bodegas Borsao, Campo de Borja, Spain  
A deep aroma of ripe berries, on the palate it is a full bodied wine with pleasant tannin in perfect harmony with its acidity, delicious.
- 261 Rioja Tempranillo 2014** **24.00**  
Vega del Rey, Briones, La Rioja, Spain  
A modern, vibrant, unoaked tempranillo. Oozing with red fruits, fresh cherries and plums with hints of spicy complexity. Soft and easy to drink with approachable ripe fruit yet well-structured.
- 262 Rioja Reserva 2011** **32.00**  
Vina Izadi, Rioja, Spain  
Deep ruby colour with very intense aromas of red fruit and a touch of cedar. On the palate, it is ripe, with good depth of nicely developed mature red fruit, lovely balance and rounded structure.
- 263 Tomas Cusiné Vilosell 2011** **35.00**  
Costers del Segre, Catalonia, Spain  
Dark cherry red in colour. A nose of raspberries, blueberries and spice. Intense and structured on the palate. With a long and persistent finish.
- 264 Finca Villacreces 'Pruno' 2014** **38.00**  
Ribera del Duero, Spain  
Deep cherry red in colour, red fruits with a hint of spice on the nose, leading to a finish that is full and lingering.
- 265 L'Expressió del Priorat 2015** **39.00**  
Mas La Mola, Priorat, Catalunya, Spain  
Powerful and seductive with blueberry fruit on the nose. Juicy and fruit driven, luscious on the palate with hints of herbs and spices and a long berry and black cherry finish.

## Portugal

- 270 Vallado Douro Tinto 2012** **37.00**  
Quinta do Vallado, Douro, Portugal  
A thoroughly modern take on a classic blend of Portuguese grapes (Touriga Nacional (25%), Touriga Franca (20%), Tinta Roriz, Tinta Amarela, Tinta Barroca and Sousão) with rich, damson flavours but very clean lines and great structure.

## New Zealand

- 280 Stopbanks Pinot Noir 2013** **30.00**  
Stopbanks, Marlborough, New Zealand  
Black cherry and plum on the nose. On the palate, the dark stone fruits are complemented by subtle notes of blackcurrant, while the well-balanced acidity ensures good length leading to a silky finish. Great value.
- 281 Trinity Hill 'The Trinity' 2014** **36.00**  
Trinity Hill, Hawkes Bay, South Island, New Zealand  
The leather and plum aromas of the Merlot combine with spice and red fruit characters of Tempranillo and Malbec. Cassis aromas and structural backbone are provided by the Cabernet Franc. Richness and soft, ripe tannins make a serious yet eminently drinkable wine.
- 282 Kim Crawford Pinot Noir 2015** **40.00**  
Kim Crawford, Marlborough, New Zealand

### EU Allergen Wine Advice

Under EU legislation we are required to inform you of food and drink we sell that has a sulphur dioxide (sulphates, SO<sub>2</sub>) content above 10mg. Per kilo or litre. Sulphites are present in almost all wines, as a preservative. It is used in winemaking (and indeed most food industries), because of its antioxidant and antibacterial properties. SO<sub>2</sub> plays a very important role in maintaining a wine's freshness. Without it, most wines would not keep. We have checked our wine list and the labels, and all state that sulphites are present, as they must above 10mg. levels. 'Organic' wines usually have no added sulphur dioxide, but it is created naturally anyway in the fermentation process. The actual amounts in each bottle we don't know, but as a guide the average is about 80 mg. /litre. Red wines need less sulphites and an average of about 50mg. Is likely. White wines more, around 120mg. And sweet white wines especially, with up to 350mg. per litre.
