- 20 Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie 2017** **24.00**  
Domaine de la Batardiere, Loire Valley, France  
Ageing on the lees gives this wine added depth and complexity. Fresh and hard to resist.
- 21 Sancerre Blanc 2015** **44.00**  
Domaine Sautereau, Crèzancy, France  
Vibrant aromas of nettle, grapefruit and passionfruit. The palate is elegant in texture, with refreshing acidity and medium body.

### Burgundy

- 30 Bourgogne Aligoté 'Closierie des Alisiers' 2015/ 2016** **36.00**  
Domaine Stéphane Brocard, Burgundy, France  
Young and fruity, this wine shows the natural crispness of the Aligoté. It has minerality, acidity and layers of fruitiness - it makes a great sharpener!
- 31 Chablis 2015** **40.00**  
Domaine de la Motte, Chablis, France  
A classic Chablis from vines grown on the famous Kimmeridgian clay with nervy, mineral fruit but added depth from a small, around 10%, addition of some oak aged wine into the blend. This is very typical of the Motte style and gives a richness and balance to the wine.
- 32 Macon-Igé 'Château London' 2014** **40.00**  
Jean-Claude Boisset, Nuits-St-Georges, Burgundy, France  
Bright, with an attractive nose of white flowers, citrus and peach. The palate is lively with long, zesty acidity on the finish.
- 33 St Aubin 1er Cru 'La Chataniere' 2015** **55.00**  
Domaine Roux, Burgundy, France  
The colour of sunshine. Aromas of white flowers, flint, green almond, and orange-flower. Rich and firm, just delicious.
- 34 Chassagne-Montrachet 'Les Chaumes' 2012** **57.00**  
Domaine Roux, Burgundy, France  
A mature, complex and sophisticated wine with depth and character - ripe yellow and green fruits, good spice and a touch of blossom.

## Alsace

- 40 Pinot Blanc 'Klevner' Réserve 2016** **36.00**  
Cave de Hunawihr, Alsace, France  
Pale straw yellow in colour, the nose is full of youth and freshness, typical of this vintage. It opens with fine hints of apricot and yellow plum. The mouth is full and very fresh.
- 41 Gewürztraminer Réserve 2013** **34.00**  
Cave de Turckheim, Alsace, France  
Pale golden colour with perfumed aromatics of lychees, rose petals and spice. A fantastic wine with great complexity, full bodied with spice and intense fruit on the finish.

## Regional France

- 60 Picpoul de Pinet 2017** **29.00**  
Baron de Badassière, Languedoc, France  
Bright yellow in colour with vibrant citrus, pear and spice notes on the nose. The palate is full but extremely well-balanced, with fresh Picpoul acidity and pure fruit flavours.
- 61 Chardonnay de La Chevalière 2014 / 2016** **29.00**  
Mas La Chevaliere, Languedoc, France  
Gold in colour, this wine is lovely and expressive, rich and full of peach and apricot aromas with tropical notes.
- 62 Costières de Nîmes 2017** **32.00**  
Château Roubaud, Languedoc, France  
Made from 60% Roussanne and 40% Grenache Blanc, it makes an ideal aperitif and stands up well to food too.

## Italy

- 71 Pinot Grigio Principato 2016** **22.00**  
Principato, IGT Pavia, Italy  
Appealing fruit aromas mingle with delicate floral notes. Crisp, light and elegant.
- 72 Gavi di Gavi 2015** **35.00**  
Comune di Gavi Patrizi, Piemonte, Italy  
Delicate with intense fruity & lemony notes. Clean and fresh with a long lingering citrusy finish.
- 73 Pieropan Soave 2015** **35.00**  
Leonildo Pieropan, Soave, Veneto, Italy  
Fresh and expressive, with a character of white flowers, almond blossom and a touch of citrus. It has great balance between rounded, ripe fruit and a fresh, clean acidity. Long and fragrant.
- 74 Pinot Grigio Dolomiti 2015** **36.00**  
Alois Lageder, Alto Adige, Italy  
Brilliant straw yellow with a green shimmer, an expressive aroma with flowery and somewhat spicy notes. Rich flavoured in the mouth, with a slight smokiness leading to a good, fresh finish.
- 75 Franz Haas "Manna" 2015** **47.00**  
Trentino, Alto Adige, Italy  
Franz produces wines that show a rare purity and balance and light gold in colour, Manna Cru is a perfectly balanced blend combining depth and texture, perfume and body to produce a crisp, lively wine with tremendous length and character.

## Spain

- 80 Borsao Rubic, Macabeo 2017** **20.00**  
Bodegas Borsao, Campo de Borja, Spain  
On the nose, citrus and tropical fruit aromas. In the mouth it's creamy and fresh, in perfect harmony with the acidity.
- 81 K-Naia 2017** **29.00**  
Bodegas Naia, La Seca, Rueda, Spain  
Made with 85% Verdejo and 15% Sauvignon Blanc grapes, this wine delivers intense sensations of refreshing white fruit and crisp minerality. It is very approachable and goes with food or as an aperitif.
- 82 Vetus 'Flor de Vetus' rueda Verdejo 2016** **32.00**  
Toro, Castilla y Leon, Spain  
A crisp, fresh style of Verdejo from Rueda DO where the Izadi family also own vineyards. On the nose it is intense and harmonious with a rich citrus and peach fruit character. On the palate tropical notes with ripe lemon touches lead onto a long, lively and refreshing finish.
- 83 Albariño 'A20' 2016** **35.00**  
Castro Martin, Rías Baixas, Spain  
Fresh and zesty with aromatic peach, apricot and lime zest on the nose. The palate is sleek and racy with juicy green apple, a hint of honey, crisp lemon and lime acidity.

## Austria

- 90 Grüner Veltliner 'Lois' 2014** **35.00**  
Loimer, Kamptal, Austria  
Youthful lemon in colour with lively, crisp nose with perfumes of fresh green apples and a touch of blackcurrant on the nose. It has a characteristic spicy quality to the palate, with a perfect balance between zesty acidity and ripe fruit.

## Germany

- 96 Dreissigacker Estate Reisling 2015** **36.00**  
Dreissigacker, Rheinhessen, Germany  
Jochen Dreissigacker has caused a considerable stir both in his native Germany and abroad, winning high praise and points wherever his wines are sold. Light in colour with green reflexes. The fruity, elegant nose is rich and medium-bodied, with aromas of ripe fruits. The palate is elegant, very well-balanced, and full of yellow fruit character before a long finish.

## New Zealand

- 110 Whale Watcher Sauvignon Blanc 2016** **27.00**  
Malborough, New Zealand  
Perfumed with nettle ripe tropical fruits which are also evident on the palate along with limey flavours and a rich minerality - classic Marlborough Sauvignon. The wine is sappy fresh, clean and delicious. Try with white fish, seafood, grilled asparagus, and avocado with prawns.
- 111 Te Kairanga Riesling 2017** **30.00**  
Wairarapa, New Zealand  
A refreshing aromatic Riesling made in an off-dry style; the aromatic perfumed fruit is offset by Granny Smith apple, lime blossom, kaffir lime zest and honeysuckle. The gently scented fruit and spice is accentuated on the palate by a mineral, citrusy acidity. The perfectly poised balance makes this a versatile and complex food wine.
- 112 Greywacke Sauvignon Blanc 2016** **39.00**  
Greywacke, Marlborough, New Zealand  
Greywacke was created in 2009 by Kevin Judd, chief winemaker at Cloudy Bay from its inception for 25 years and instrumental in the international recognition which Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc enjoys now. Deliciously aromatic, exuding enticing fruit fragrance.
- 113 Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2015 / 2016** **49.00**  
Cloudy Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand  
Iconic Sauvignon Blanc from one of the leading producers of it in the world.

## Australia

- 121 Dandelion Reisling 'Enchanted Garden of the Eden Valley' 2015** **35.00**  
Dandelion Vineyards, Eden Valley, South Australia  
Classic aromatics of citrus zest and a clear steely minerality, bone dry underpinned by structure and nice acidity.
- 122 Keith Tullcok Chardonnay** **38.00**  
Hunter Valley, NSW  
Fruit aromas of white stone fruit, yellow melon and fig, with detailed elements of winemaking complexity interwoven to generate much more richness of perfume and textural softness and length.

Fairview, Paarl, South Africa  
A fresh, lively perfume of ripe pears and honeysuckle, rich and rounded, with a crisp finish.
- 131 Circle of Life** **37.00**  
Waterkloof, Stellenbosch  
Citrus and lemon flavours, with slight peachy notes on the nose. A tight mineral core and creamy middle pallet allows for great complexity and a persistent finish.☒

## South America

**140 Predregoso Grand Reserva Sauvignon Blanc 29.00**

Tabalia, Limari Valley, Chile

Intense, complex and elegant on the nose with citric notes and gentle green pepper aromas. The palate shows great volume with crisp, high acidity giving chalky minerality and a fresh, long, fruity finish. Great with fresh fish dishes such as sushi or carpaccio of tuna.

Fermented in steel and kept well away from oak barrels this Viognier shows big peach and apricot flavours mixed with citrus and floral notes. Full-bodied and a powerhouse of flavour.

**151 Neilson by Byron Santa Maria Valley Chardonnay 42.00**

Byron, California, USA

Rich, spicy and with well balanced oaky tones, this exudes a honeyed quality along with pineapple, citrus and mineral notes. The brisk Santa Maria acidity provides clean, mouthwatering balance to this opulent, richly textured wine that has fantastic length and flavour.

- 200 Saint Nicolas de Bourgueil "L'Expression" 2015/ 2016 37.00**  
Taluuu and Foltzenlogel, Saint Nicolas de Bourgueil, Loire Valley, France  
An easy-drinking and expressive capsicum-scented Cabernet Franc. This has a lovely concentration of fruit and a really persistent finish.

### Beaujolais

- 210 Beaujolais-Villages 2016 33.00**  
Dominique Morel, Domaine de Gry-Sablon, Beaujolais, France  
Clear ruby with delicate cherry perfumes. The rounded palate is full of fresh red berry fruit. Elegant, well balanced with good acidity, a great example of Beaujolais-Villages.
- 211 Fleurie 2017 35.00**  
La Reine de L'Arenite, Fleurie  
A heady perfume of freshly picked irises and peonies drift above the crushed berry fruit nose. Ripe tannins and fresh acidity support a palate of Morello cherries and bitter dark chocolate (reminiscent of a not too sweet Black Forest Gâteaux).
- 212 Brouilly, Le Cru du Volcan 2017 35.00**  
Domaine Les Roches Bleues, Beaujolais, France  
lums, raspberry and violets on the nose with an earthy, mildly sticky, sappy tannin profile. Fresh and fruity but with a distinctive savoury edge.

### Burgundy

- 220 Bourgogne Pinot Noir 'Les Ursulines' 2014 40.00**  
Jean-Claude Boisset, Nuits-St-Georges, Burgundy, France  
Firmness, attractive cherry perfume and scented length expected of far greater wines. Excellent value.



## Bordeaux

- 230 58 Guineas Claret** **27.00**  
Maison Ginestet Bordeaux, France  
Now starting to show some lovely bottle age, blackcurrant and blackberry on the nose, the delicious maturity shows on the palate, then ends with a long mellow finish.
- 231 Château D'Abzac 2015** **36.00**  
Bordeaux Supérieur, Bordeaux, France  
Château d'Abzac is located 6km north west of Pomerol where this wine is made from mainly merlot grapes. Its alluring red berry aromas precede a palate that has a wealth of cassis flavours, great concentration and fine balance. It really is very nice.
- 232 Château La Lagune 'Mademoiselle L' 2014** **43.00**  
Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, France  
With inviting perfumes of cassis and light vanilla, this is a well-structured wine that is full of red fruit flavours, which intermingle with notes of blackcurrant and plum. The gentle oak supports the supple tannins on the long finish of red and black berries.
- 233 Château Tour de Capet 2012** **52.00**  
Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux, France  
Made mainly from Merlot, giving juicy cassis and plum fruit flavours and an appealing round finish. A small proportion of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc give a lifted perfume and cedar flavour to the palate.
- 234 Château Durfort-Vivens "Vivens" 2012** **62.00**  
Margaux, Bordeaux, France  
The nose has intense aromas of cassis and blackberries. Ample and round with soft tannins and spicy notes. A very stylish and balanced wine.
- 235 Chateau Batailley, Pauillac 2007** **75.00**  
Chateau Batailley, Pauillac, Beaujolais, France  
One of the oldest Chateau's in Pauillac. The 2007 vintage has an attractive expressive cabernet nose with notes of cassis on the palate. A very classic left bank claret with a touch of dry tannin on the finish.
- 236 Château Petit Village 'Le jardin de Petit Village' 2013** **81.00**  
Pomerol, Bordeaux, France  
The nose is concentrated with floral notes, red and black fruit as well as exotic woods and leather. On the palate there are fine tannins and very pleasant fruity flavours with well integrated oak, finishing with great length.

## Rhone

- 240 Côtes du Rhône 2017** **25.00**  
La Chapelle de Marin, Cotes du Rhone, France  
With attractive, bramble fruit and floral aromas, the palate is up-front and fresh with warm spice and real depth. This is a classic southern Rhône red; ripe and characterful with smooth supple tannins.
- 241 Lirac 2015** **35.00**  
Moulin des Chênes, Lirac, Rhône, France  
Full and soft, made mainly from Syrah, Grenache and Mourvèdre. It is generous in body with supple tannins and primary fruit. Fresh, with a long, mellow finish.
- 242 Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2013** **48.00**  
Domaine Chante Cigale, Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Rhône, France  
Deep purple with violet hues. A rich deep nose of red and black fruits and spices. Soft and round in the mouth with a harmonious and persistent finish.
- 243 Gigondas 'Domaine des Bosquets' 2015** **52.00**  
Château de Vaudieu, Gigondas, Rhône, France  
Purple, inky colour. A complex nose of black and red berries, liquorice and violets. Generous, ripe fruit with huge depth and fresh lingering finish.

## Regional France

- 249 Saint-Chinian "Cuveé Magali" 2013** **30.00**  
Jean Lacugue, Ch. Milhau-Lacugue, Puisseguier, Languedoc, France  
Made from roughly equal volumes of Syrah, Grenache Noir and Carignan, it is a juicy, readily accessible wine packed with ripe plum and berry flavours over a framework of supple tannins.

## Italy

- 251 Cesconi 'Moratel' 2014** **39.00**  
Trentino, Alto Adige, Italy  
Made with 40% Lagrein, 40% Merlot, 10% Teroldego and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. The nose is aromatic and complex, full of cherry, raspberry and blackcurrant. On the palate it is nicely balanced with a long lingering finish. A really nice choice.
- 253 Barolo Patrizi 2011** **47.00**  
Cantine Manfredi, Piemonte, Italy  
Open and spicy nose with notes of berry fruits, plum, wood smoke and leather. Rich red berry fruit on the palate with good concentration, hints of spicy tar, liquorice and meaty notes. A warm mid-palate leading to the characteristic firm, structured finish.

## Spain

- 260 Borsao Rubic Garnacha Tinto 2016** **20.00**  
Bodegas Borsao, Campo de Borja, Spain  
A deep aroma of ripe berries, on the palate it is a full bodied wine with pleasant tannin in perfect harmony with its acidity, delicious.
- 261 Rioja Tempranillo 2016** **25.00**  
Vega del Rey, Briones, La Rioja, Spain  
A modern, vibrant, unoaked tempranillo. Oozing with red fruits, fresh cherries and plums with hints of spicy complexity. Soft and easy to drink with approachable ripe fruit yet well-structured.
- 262 Tomas Cusiné Vilosell 2015** **36.00**  
Costers del Segre, Catalonia, Spain  
Dark cherry red in colour. A nose of raspberries, blueberries and spice. Intense and structured on the palate. With a long and persistent finish.
- 263 Rioja Reserva 2013** **36.00**  
Vina Izadi, Rioja, Spain  
Deep ruby colour with very intense aromas of red fruit and a touch of cedar. On the palate, it is ripe, with good depth of nicely developed mature red fruit, lovely balance and rounded structure.
- 264 Finca Villacreces 'Pruno' 2015** **38.00**  
Ribera del Duero, Spain  
Deep cherry red in colour, red fruits with a hint of spice on the nose, leading to a finish that is full and lingering.
- 265 L'Expressió del Priorat 2016** **39.00**  
Mas La Mola, Priorat, Catalunya, Spain  
Powerful and seductive with blueberry fruit on the nose. Juicy and fruit driven, luscious on the palate with hints of herbs and spices and a long berry and black cherry finish.

## Portugal

- 270 Vallado Douro Tinto 2015** **37.00**  
Quinta do Vallado, Douro, Portugal  
A thoroughly modern take on a classic blend of Portuguese grapes (Touriga Nacional (25%), Touriga Franca (20%), Tinta Roriz, Tinta Amarela, Tinta Barroca and Sousão) with rich, damson flavours but very clean lines and great structure.

## New Zealand

- 280 Moko Black Pinot Noir 2014** **34.00**  
Malborough, New Zealand  
Dark fruit notes with some black pepper - in some ways perhaps more akin to a good old-vine Grenache than a Pinot Noir but lovely at the same time. Has savoury bay-leaf character to balance out the supple fruit. Made to go with delicate, rich and aromatic food such as duck, tempura fried vegetables and oriental salads.
- 282 Kim Crawford Pinot Noir 2015** **40.00**  
Kim Crawford, Marlborough, New Zealand  
Aromas of cherries and plums, with a hint of redcurrant. Attractive floral notes also shine through which are nicely integrated with toasty oak characters. The tannins are soft and silky, and well balanced acidity ensures good length of flavour.
- 283 Greywacke Pinot Noir 2012 / 2014** **55.00**  
Greywacke, Marlborough, New Zealand  
Greywacke was created in 2009 by Kevin Judd, formally chief winemaker at Cloudy Bay. Here, ripe fruit aromas intermingle with a sweet-scented floral perfume. The palate blends blackberries and cherry with hints of smoky vanilla oak.

## Australia

- 290 Soldier's Block Shiraz 2018** **26.00**  
Victoria, Australia  
The nose is full of ripe and juicy red fruits. On the palate underlying the generous fruit is a more subtle layer of plum stone, star anise and cinnamon which adds complexity and interest. The soft powdery tannins provide a gentle finish.
- 291 Giant Steps 'Harrys Monster' 2013** **45.00**  
Giant Steps, Yarra Valley, Victoria, Australia  
A bright deep crimson powerful and intense Bordeaux blend. Full-bodied and densely packed with fruit and spice, with a long lingering finish.
- 292 John Duval 'Plexus', Shiraz, Grenache, Mouvedre 2014** **47.00**  
John Duval Wines, Barossa Valley, Australia  
Red and black berry aromatics, generous on the palate. Soft texture and fine tannins with a dark cherry and spice finish, delicious!

## South Africa

- 300 Fairview Pinotage 2016** **30.00**  
Paarl, South Africa  
Matured in a combination of French and Italian oak barrels, enhancing its rich, ripe fruit. It has aromas of mulberries, black fruit, vanilla and spices and has a supple full mouthed feel. Red meat will be complimented by this wine.
- 301 Journeys End Cabernet Sauvignon 'The Cape Doctor' 2011** **45.00**  
Journeys End, Stellenbosch, South Africa  
Journeys End are 100% committed to producing top-quality single-vineyard and appellation wines that are intricate, integrated, and true to the terroir of the vineyards and climatic benefits of the region.
- 302 De Trafford 'Elevation 393' 2007** **75.00**  
De Trafford, Stellenbosch, South Africa  
Made from 42% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Merlot, 17% Shiraz and 8% Cabernet Franc. Lush blackberry and spicy fruitcake aromas. Dense tannins and intense cassis fruit provide a rich, supple, almost thick texture.

## South America

### EU Allergen Wine Advice

Under EU legislation we are required to inform you of food and drink we sell that has a sulphur dioxide (sulphates, SO<sub>2</sub>) content above 10mg. Per kilo or litre. Sulphites are present in almost all wines, as a preservative. It is used in winemaking (and indeed most food industries), because of its antioxidant and antibacterial properties. SO<sub>2</sub> plays a very important role in maintaining a wine's freshness. Without it, most wines would not keep. We have checked our wine list and the labels, and all state that sulphites are present, as they must above 10mg. levels. 'Organic' wines usually have no added sulphur dioxide, but it is created naturally anyway in the fermentation process. The actual amounts in each bottle we don't know, but as a guide the average is about 80 mg. /litre. Red wines need less sulphites and an average of about 50mg. Is likely. White wines more, around 120mg. And sweet white wines especially, with up to 350mg. per litre.
